CANCELLATION POLICY

DEPOSITS:

•Non-refundable

•Non-transferable

•Considered earned by ACTS upon receipt - and by which time ACTS has spent considerable time in making arrangements on your behalf.

NO-SHOWS:

If any participant or the group as a whole, does not show up for the scheduled tour departure, the participant or group is considered cancelled of its own volition.

IF ACTS CANCELS YOUR TOUR:

If ACTS cancels your group's tour (as opposed to you cancelling, or the school cancelling, or you individually being cancelled for non-payment) we must and will refund your money within fourteen (14) days.

WITHIN THE LAST FIFTY

(50) DAYS OF DEPARTURE:

•Charged one and one-half (1½) times the amount of your deposit.

•Charged the total amount of all non-refundable amounts paid and that will be required to be paid, on your behalf as a result of your cancellation, including any rooming supplement your absence would necessitate.

•Any costs or penalties associated with airline tickets are charged to someone cancelling once an airline ticket has been written. This could be the entire cost of the airline ticket.

•ACTS may cancel any participant not fully paid, and in such case all of the cancellation charges within this column apply.

WITHIN THE LAST EIGHT

(8) DAYS OF DEPARTURE:

•There is no refund for cancellations occurring within the last eight days of departure.

LATE PAYMENTS:

- All payments must be postmarked on or before the due date.
- There is a 10 day grace period to allow for mail delay.
- Payments received after this time, including payments made by check if a credit card charge request is refused, must include a late fee of fifteen (\$15) dollars.
- Late fees must be paid before tour departure.
- Payments made within fifty (50) days prior to departure must be made by money order, cashier's check, or credit card.
- There is a twenty-five (\$25) dollar fee for checks returned "NSF" - non-sufficient funds.

INSURE AMERICA

Every paid participant on our tours, is automatically covered by an insurance policy provided by INSURE AMERICA, as long as the participant is registered 75 or more days prior to the tour date.

The coverage limit on this policy is five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) per participant.

In addition to providing medical insurance, the coverage also includes a package of additional benefits called TRAVEL GUARD ASSISTANCE. The medical insurance coverage applies only while you are on tour and has restrictions and limitations.

You will receive a Certificate of Insurance when you make your final payment. Review it carefully. The medical insurance provided by Insure America is secondary to any other medical insurance you may have. If you have no other medical insurance, it is primary.

LISTED CONDITIONS

- Tour participant waives and releases any and all claims against ACTS for delays, losses, or accidents involving tour participants or their belongings by whatsoever cause.
- ACTS specifically disclaims any liability for accidents involving swimming activities. Tour participants swim at their own risk.
- ACTS reserves the right to withdraw the tour, or any part of it, to make alterations in the itinerary which to us seem necessary, or to substitute services of comparable value, to refuse to accept or retain as a member of the group any person, at any time, and to pass on to tour participants any costs brought on by events beyond our control.
- Should any transportation supplier make a special assessment, or should a governmental agency levy any tax or assessment, we reserve the right to pass on such costs.
- Tour participants agree that any photographic or video images that might be taken of them by ACTS may be used by ACTS or its sister company for promotional purposes without further authorization or compensation.
- Limitation of Liability. Liability against ACTS, its agents and its representatives is expressly limited to the price of the tour, whether any such claims are in contract, tort, or equity.
- By signing this document you agree and consent to personal jurisdiction in either the Circuit Court of Barron County, Wisconsin, or the United States District Court, District of Wisconsin, Western District, that the laws of the State of Wisconsin shall apply to any disputes between you and ACTS and that any litigation initiated by either you or ACTS and relating in any way to this document or the services we provide shall be venued in either the Circuit Court of Barron County, Wisconsin, or the United States District Court, District of Wisconsin, Western District.

ACTS FINANCIAL PROTECTION PLAN

How Your Money is protected under ACTS Financial Protection Plan: ACTS has a client trust account with Dairy State Bank administered by an independent firm of Certified Public Accountants. All of your payments are payable directly to a special FDIC insured client trust account at Dairy State Bank in Rice Lake, Wisconsin. American Christian Tours (ACTS) will process your payments and remit them to a Certified Public Accounting firm which will then deposit them with Dairy State Bank. The firm of Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants, will then make payments for your tour as those payments come due. Your initial deposit, which is non-refundable, will be paid to ACTS by Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants upon request by ACTS. All other amounts will remain in the trust account for payment of trip bills. Finally, five (5) banking days after the scheduled completion of the tour (and after ACTS should have rendered the services to you) Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants will remit to ACTS that money still in the group's account and ACTS will pay the remaining miscellaneous bills. In the highly unlikely event that ACTS ceases to operate, you must file a refund claim with Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants for that portion of the money you paid which is in the client trust account. Your claim must be filed no later than two days after your scheduled return date. Claims must be submitted to Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants at 827 Hammond Avenue, Rice Lake, WI, 54868.

This special financial protection is meant to make sure that funds will be available to pay the providers of accommodations and services for your tour, and provides a level of financial security for you that is unmatched in the student tour industry. The client trust account is not intended to circumvent the provisions of this document including those found within the "Cancellations", "Conditions", and "Behavior Guidelines" sections. In other words, it is not meant to let people avoid cancellation fees, etc. The Agreement between the Certified Public Accountants and ACTS says that "This Agreement shall not obligate the Certified Public Accountants to hold account funds in the event of a dispute between tour participants and ACTS. Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants may rely on any notice or instruction of ACTS...provided such notice or instruction directs Anderson, Hager and Moe, Certified Public Accountants to make a distribution permitted under this Agreement."
